When and what will you study?

Semester dates:

Winter: 1 October - 31 March



• **Summer**: 1 April - 31 August (arrive 1 week before the start of the semester)

Our Teaching Model - CORE

We teach in block modules
One semester = 4 block modules + 1

band module + 1 language or elective module
Each module = 5 ECTS
You must complete full modules to receive credit

Application steps



- **Pre-Arrival Sessions** (3 & 2 months before semester)
- Welcome Day 1 week before semester starts
- Orientation Week right before lectures begin You will get a full schedule from Student Services)

Application process:

1. Online via <u>Dreamapply portal</u> (choose your campus)

 Upload all required documents
 You receive a study contract + invoice (sign and submit study contract and pay the invoice within 30 days)
 After completing these steps, you receive Acceptance letter from us

Tuition & Language requirements



Fees:

€250 Enrollment fee

EU/EWR students - €4500 per semester **Non-EU students** - €5500 per semester

Mandatory public transportation ticket



Language skills:

- Proof of B2.2/C1 level of English/German proficency
- Accepted tests: IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge, DSH, TestDaF (the test has to be taken within the last 24 months)
 If you are a German or English native speaker: you can upload your ID or passport instead of a language certificate

We use the ECTS system: **1 ECTS = 25-30 hrs** Students can take maximum of **6 modules / 30 ECTS** per semester

Your transcript will be available to download from Student portal 4-6 weeks after the semester ends You can find available courses for you on the <u>Customize Your Studies portal</u>.

- Bachelor students can choose only Bachelor-level courses. (Exception: If your Bachelor program at your home university is longer than 4 years and you are in your final year, you may also select Master-level courses.)
- Master students can choose only

Master-level courses.

Grades:

The grading system ranges from 1,0 to 5,0 with 1,0 being the best grade and 4,0 being the pass grade; 5,0 means failed. (Some modules are graded as Pass/Fail only)

Housing, Cost of Living & Insurance

Accommodation:

SRH doesn't offer housing, but you'll get a Welcome Guide with housing tips. Many students rent with <u>AGSA</u>.

Monthly Budget:

Berlin, Heidelberg, Hamburg: €900-€1200 Leipzig, Dresden: €700-€900

Health insurance:

Public health insurance, required by law, for enrollement in German University - must be submitted **before semester starts.**



Visa & Residence Permit:

- EU students: No visa needed, just <u>city</u> <u>registration</u>
- Non-EU: Check with the German Embassy in your country
