As Disability and Inclusion Officers, we offer the following support:

- Individual advice on available support options to help you organise your studies successfully – even before you begin your course

- Guidance on the requirements and forms of reasonable adjustments for university admission, during your studies and for examinations, in cooperation with the examinations office
- Mediation and communication support between you, academic staff and administration, where required
- Raising awareness within the university community about the needs of students with health conditions or disabilities
- Participation in university committees to help remove barriers and further develop effective measures for reasonable adjustments
- Promoting cooperation with external care and counselling services

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
