Declaration of participation – Germany Scholarship SRH University of Applied Sciences Heidelberg

I hereby confirm that that I have read and understood the data protection information.

In particular, I have been informed that I am free to determine the scope of personal data provided for the application for the Germany Scholarship. I have taken note that it is up to me to decide what information I provide for the application. Furthermore, I declare my consent that the personal data provided by me in accordance with § 10 StipG will be processed by SRH University of Applied Sciences Heidelberg for the purpose of selection for a Germany Scholarship and, if applicable, for the purpose of granting a Germany Scholarship. I can revoke this consent at any time. If I revoke this consent, my data will be deleted immediately and the documents submitted will be destroyed in accordance with data protection regulations.

Please note: If consent is not given or is revoked, the scholarship applied for cannot be granted or can no longer be granted.

Note on data protection

The personal data you provide here will be treated confidentially and will be collected and processed exclusively for the purpose of selecting suitable applicants and implementing the Germany Scholarship. The legal basis for this is Section 10 of the Scholarship Programme Act (StipG). According to this, applicants for the scholarship programme are obliged to provide the information necessary to assess their performance and suitability and to submit the relevant evidence. It is up to you to decide which of this information you provide: tell us what qualifies you for the Germany Scholarship!

We are aware that some of the information provided is highly confidential, and some of the information (e.g. about illnesses, migration background) is also considered special categories of personal data within the meaning of data protection laws. Your data will always be treated confidentially and, together with our IT service provider, protected with the latest technical security measures.

If your application is not successful in this selection process, you can let us know if you do not want your application data to be kept for a new application.

Statistics/evaluation anonymisation

In accordance with Section 13 of the Scholarship Programme Act, we are obliged to transmit scholarship holder data to the State Statistical Office for the purpose of compiling federal statistics. This is done under a pseudonym, i.e. without disclosing your name.

Contact with the sponsor

Your sponsor may wish to get to know you in order to invite you to events or perhaps offer you an internship. However, this contact is only possible if you consent to your data being disclosed to the sponsor. This is entirely voluntary.
